### Pre-Conference Lab - Cerebral Bypass and Microsurgical Skills Lab

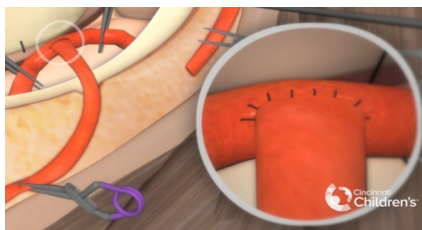

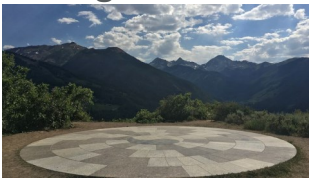
## Outside Activities
