Tragically, as the opioid-substance use epidemic continues in our country, the number of young children affected is increasing. Many children are identified, but appropriate treatment is uncertain. Cincinnati Children's and the Collaborative for Children of Addicted Parents invite you to this year's conference to explore treatment options for children (age 0-5) and their families affected by familial substance abuse disorders.
