

Pediatric Grand Rounds 2020

Maintenance of Certification (MOC) Part 2

Cincinnati Children's will offer several Pediatric Grand Rounds in 2020 that are eligible for ABP MOC Part 2 points. To receive ABP MOC 2 Points, participants must attend/view and pass an online post-test. Presentations will be announced as "MOC Eligible" at cincinnatichildrens.org/cme. Participation can be in-person, online, or a combination, but must be completed by **October 30, 2020** (to be reported in calendar year 2020).

Instructions to receive ABP MOC 2 credit after texting attendance in-person at PGR:

-) Visit www.cincinnatichildrens.org/cmetests
 - o (The test can also be found in the "Online Courses" area of the database and app.)
-) If you need to sign-in to the continuing education portal, do so at this time.
-) Tests associated with your account are listed. Find today's Pediatric Grand Rounds test in the list.
-) Click "complete test".
-) Answer both questions to pass the test. If you do not pass, you may retake the test.
-) After passing, click complete evaluation.
-) You must complete the evaluation or it will not record the credit.
-) **If this is your first MOC activity in 2020, ensure your Account Profile has correct ABP Diplomate ID and Month and Date of Birth (<https://cchmc.cloud-cme.com>)**

ABP MOC Part 2 is provided complimentary to medical staff members. Non-medical staff members will be charged a \$10 processing fee per MOC credit claimed for MOC Eligible PGR. The CME Office will contact non-medical staff members for payment quarterly. Credit will not be reported until payment is processed.

Successful completion of this CME activity, which includes participation in the activity and individual assessment of and feedback to the learner, enables the learner to earn up to 1.0 MOC points per session in the American Board of Pediatrics' (ABP) Maintenance of Certification (MOC) program. It is the CME activity provider's responsibility to submit learner completion information to ACCME for the purpose of granting ABP MOC credit.
