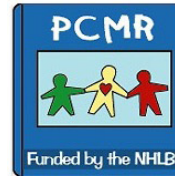

# OVERVIEW



The 6th International Conference on Cardiomyopathy in Children is a virtual conference to be held on May 10–11, 2024.

This **CME credited** event aims to identify knowledge gaps, determine research directions, and provide updates on **medical management** that will lead to a better understanding of pediatric cardiomyopathy and effective intervention strategies.

This meeting will bring together a **multidisciplinary group** of medical and healthcare professionals from **top medical centers**. Through presentations, case studies, and panel discussions, leaders in the field of pediatric heart failure and cardiomyopathy will focus on:

- **Sharing updates** on the prevention, diagnosis, and medical management of cardiomyopathy
- Discussing **new developments** in genetics, etiology, and epidemiology
- Identifying the **most promising areas** for basic science, translational, and clinical research on pediatric cardiomyopathy
- Discussing **research approaches** for developing treatment guidelines and standardizing medical care
- Exploring **research collaborations** across medical centers and with pharmaceutical, medical device, and biotech industries

# CONFERENCE SESSIONS

The 6th International Conference on Cardiomyopathy in Children will provide a venue for the exchange of knowledge and evaluation of research needs so that new approaches and technologies can be identified to improve disease prevention and intervention.

The conference will be organized into **5 different sessions** consisting of short reviews or overview presentations followed by case studies, panel discussions, or debates organized by the session leaders.

**Proceedings from the conference** will be published in Elsevier's, *Progress in Pediatric Cardiology*. Past conferences have produced a total of **132 published articles** on pediatric cardiomyopathy.
