Acute Care Research Leadership & Innovations Awards

Acute Care Research Council (ACRC)

The Acute Care Research Leadership & Innovations Award program has been established to honor leadership, innovation, and engagement in acute care research that advances the mission of the Acute Care Research Council. Acute Care Research (ACR) is research related to a time-sensitive condition, associated with a visit to an emergency department or unscheduled admission, or identification of a new or worsening condition — characterized by sudden onset requiring immediate care (includes surveys, observational, interventional).

ACRC's mission is to generate and execute world-class research initiatives through empowering our stakeholders, improving efficiency of the research process, training our next generation clinical and translational researcher, and developing acute care research standards of care – all to advance patient outcomes in the challenging and fast-paced acute care setting. **Nominator** (person submitting a nominee) **instructions**: Nominations must be submitted via <u>REDCap</u> survey. Each nominator may submit nominees for multiple categories –and- submit multiple nominees for a single category. Self-nominations accepted. Limit is 1 recommendation letter (not required). More than one award may be given in a category.

Deadline: Submission deadline is November 6, 2019. Winners and nominators will be notified the week of November 18th.

Winners will receive their awards and be recognized at the Acute Care Research Symposium awards ceremony on Monday, November 25, 2019, 11:45 am Cincinnati Children's Hospital, Sabin Auditorium.

## **Award Categories:**

- 1. Acute Care Research 'Innovation' Award: This award recognizes a *research staff individual* who has demonstrated innovation through novel intervention(s) and/or outcome(s) in ACR.
- 2. Acute Care Research 'Partner' Award: This award honors a *patient services staff individual (non-CRP)* who enthusiastically partners with acute care research teams to advance the success of ACR.
- 3. Acute Care Research 'CRP Champion' Award: This award recognizes a *Clinical Research Professional* who demonstrates commitment, passion and innovation in the application and advancement of ACR.
- 4. Acute Care Research 'Student' Award: This award recognizes an *undergraduate student, graduate student, resident, or fellow* who demonstrates commitment, passion and innovation in the application and advancement of ACR.
- 5. Acute Care Research 'Excellent Investigator' Award: This award recognizes a *principal investigator* who demonstrates excellence in commitment and innovation in the application and advancement of ACR.
