CLASSIC SHOSHONE RAPIDS ON THE COLORADO RIVER: Tuesday, July 16, 2019

Our most popular trip has withstood the test of time and boasts excellent Class III whitewater, followed by a stunning and scenic relaxing float within steep majestic canyon walls. These rapids, with names like "Superstition", "The Wall", and "Pinball", create an exhilarating section of unforgettable white water. The first section has Class III rapids and then declines to Class II & I as we focus on the beautiful scenery in the canyon. Younger children and less adventuresome adults can enter the rafts after the first set of larger rapids. Children must be over 50lbs and be able to swim. A box lunch will be served on the bus ride to the river. Please let us know if you require a vegetarian meal. **Cost: \$118.00 adult/\$109.00 child 8-12. Price includes a boxed sandwich lunch, transportation, equipment, and wilderness tax.**

Gratuity is NOT included.

Pick up will be from the Viceroy Hotel at 12:45 PM.

PLEASE BE ON TIME FOR THE DEPARTURE AS WE ARE OPERATING UNDER A TIGHT WINDOW DUE TO FORESTRY SERVICE PERMIT RESTRICTIONS.

Downhill Bicycle Tour

Maroon Bells & Lake - Maroon Creek Valley: Our tour begins with a drive to the "most photographed peaks in North America" – the Maroon Bells and Maroon Lake. At Maroon Lake, your guide will lead you on a short nature "hike", acquainting you with some of the local wildflowers and trees. After everyone has limbered up, you will begin your 12-mile downhill descent through the Maroon Valley. Along the way, you are welcome to stop and enjoy the spectacular views, and to photograph one of the most picturesque wilderness areas in Colorado. Your trip finishes in Aspen. We will stop for a refreshing snack along the way. The Maroon Bells road is closed to most vehicular traffic for the majority of the summer and affords a perfect opportunity to enjoy your downhill bike ride. **The morning trip departs at 8:20 AM and returns by 12:15 PM. The afternoon trip departs at 1:05 PM and returns by 5:00. Cost: \$113.00 adult/\$104.00 child riders 10-12 or kids on "hook-on" bikes age 6-10; \$47.50 kids under 5 in burley; Van riders: \$47.50. KID FRIENDLY ACTIVITY**

What should I Wear? Comfortable clothes. On warm, sunny days we recommend shorts, T-shirt, and tennis shoes. On cool days we recommend a sweater or light jacket. We provide rain jackets on wet days.

What should I bring? You won't need much in personal gear, and we provide all equipment. Sunglasses and sunscreen are recommended. We provide a bike pack to carry cameras.

Single Track Mountain Bike Tour

Mountain Biking Adventure: For the Beginner to Expert rider there are a variety of options: experience speed on more difficult "downhill" runs; grueling "uphill" climbs guaranteed to get the most fit heart pounding; and variations in between. As a beginner mountain biker let our experienced guides teach you the basics of shifting and pedaling in our spectacular area. These tours utilize full suspension mountain bikes on a variety of backcountry roads and single-track trails. Snacks include energy bars, fruit, and water. **The half day morning trip departs at 8:50 AM and returns by 12:30**

PM. The afternoon trip departs at 1:35 PM and returns by 5:30 PM. Cost \$120.00 per person – recommended over 12 yrs of age.

What should I Wear? Comfortable clothes. On warm, sunny days we recommend shorts, T-shirt, and tennis shoes. On cool days we recommend a sweater or light jacket. We provide rain jackets on wet days.

What should I bring? You won't need much in personal gear, and we provide all of your equipment. Sunglasses and sunscreen are recommended. We provide a bike pack to carry cameras.

Backcountry Jeep Tour

Backcountry Jeep Tour: This trip will take us up scenic Woody Creek, past the old lumber and mining town of Lenado, to the summit of Larkspur Mountain. From there you will be afforded a magnificent view of all four local ski areas, the Continental Divide, the Maroon Bells, and the entire Elk Mountain Range. **The morning trip departs at 8:20 AM and returns by 12:00 PM. The afternoon trip departs at 1:05 and returns by 5:00 PM. Cost: \$109.00 adult/ \$100.00 child 4-12. KID FRIENDLY ACTIVITY**

What Should I Wear? Always dress in layers. Most trips will reach elevations in excess of 11,000 feet where it will be cooler. A sweatshirt or jacket is recommended even on warm days.

What Should I Bring? Sunglasses, sunscreen, camera, ample supply of film and a hat are recommended.

Wilderness Hike

Novice or Intermediate Half Day: A great introduction to hiking. These trips focus on a close look at the natural environment while you enjoy scenic, secluded trails. Let us choose the "most picturesque" trail depending on time of the year and group size. Trail choices include: Difficult Creek, Snowmass Creek, Castle Creek, Rim Trail, Sunnyside on Red Mountain, or Rio Grande Trail. Round trip distance is 3-4 miles and total trip time is about 3 hours, including transportation. Includes refreshments. **The morning trip departs at 8:05 AM and returns by 11:30 AM. The afternoon trip departs at 1:05 PM and returns by 4:30 PM. Cost: \$104.00 adult/ \$95.00 child 8-12.**

What Should I Wear? Always dress in layers and wear good hiking or trail shoes. We recommend t-shirts or long sleeve shirts with a sweater and/or windbreaker on top, with long or short pants. The morning temperatures are always cooler at higher elevations, and mountain weather conditions are always subject to sudden changes.

What Should I Bring? Please bring your own pack if you have one, a camera, sunglasses, sunscreen and a visor or hat.

Sunset Dinner Tour

An evening of Colorado mountain fun includes a four-wheel drive tour into the high country, a hearty dinner in one of the area's most scenic settings and spectacular sunsets. Add great music around a roaring campfire complete with s'mores and starry skies. This is our "get away from it all" experience that you do not want to miss, as it will provide wonderful memories of your visit to the Rockies. **The trip departs at 6:05 PM from Snowmass and returns at 9:30 PM. Cost: \$127.00 adult/ \$95.00 child 12 and under/ \$75.00 3 years and under. KID FRIENDLY ACTIVITY**

What Should I Wear? Always dress warmly for the ride to and from the cabin - sweater, warm jacket and pants. We will be spending our evening in the mountains at approximately 10,000 feet and the evenings can be cool. Hiking shoes or sturdy walking shoes are recommended and a hat if you get cold easily.

What Should I Bring? A camera; a relaxed attitude and any libations you may wish to drink with your dinner.
